#### Key Themes from Chorus Discussions

- Choruses are adapting to the return to in person rehearsals or a hybrid model. Choruses continue to find creative ways to adapt to changing regulatory requirements, health challenges of leaders and members that impact their ability to participate, rehearsal venue restrictions and changes in musical leadership.
- Several choruses have found that a tangible music goal has helped the chorus focus on moving forward. Examples include preparing for regional contest, preparing for International (Woohoo YHC) or summer performances in the community.
- A few have challenges filling roles on chorus Management Team or Board. This may be of some help:
  - At the most recent Regional networking event, Region 14 shared a strategy they successfully implemented to support identifying and recruiting new RMT members.
