International Information

- Reminder to hold chorus IBOD vote and submit to International no later than November 29, 4 pm.
- Reminder re. small and mid-size chorus director scholarships (registration, room, and board) to the Director and Visual Leadership Seminar, July 25-27 in Tulsa, OK. <u>Applications</u> due January 25, 2024.
- 2025 international convention date should be announced soon, at which point Region 16 can begin scheduled our 2025 Fall Music School.

Around The Room Discussions

- Trillium Grants
 - CoH announced that they recently received a Trillium Grant and have purchased risers and a sound system with the funds. One of their members has grant experience and was instrumental in the successful application.
 - Bytown Beat has also received Trillium Grant funds of late and was able to pay for members to attend Fall Music School from part of the proceeds and will also be providing members with some Regional Assessment funding.
- Bingo funds There was discussion surrounding the fact that different municipalities seem to have
 varying requirements for approval and what the funds can be used for. Orangeville was turned
 down for Bingo in Brampton due to their association with an International organization so is
 interested in possibly re-applying in Newmarket. (Martha Grant, YHC, will send Anne Somerville,
 Orangeville, the handbook for how to apply in Newmarket.)
- Membership growth is still a challenge for most. Although successful Guest Programs have been held, most would like to see more new members. "Open Auditions" theme was successful for some.
- Eastside will be hosting a <u>Comedy Quartet contest</u> on June 13th, 2024. The question was raised as to whether Double Quartets or VLQs can participate. Susan Boissonneault will find out about this and let Sue Melvin know so this can be included in the event on the regional website.

 - Durham Shores has new Co-Director: Alana Regular.
