


How to Find Your FIRST NOTE


We as singers hear the pitch pipe being blown, but what's the first WORD? And what in the world is my FIRST NOTE?


- Sheet music and learning tracks have been purchased
- Director should study the first chord and determine the best and most logical way to "tune up"
- "tune ups" allow the singer to hear the key of the song (doh) and solidify an accurate first chord.
- Director teaches the chorus how to "tune up" (reinforced by section leaders in section rehearsals). This is especially important in the learning phase.
- Once the "tune up" has been taught and practiced it becomes the singer's responsibility to know how to "tune up" to that particular song and/or to find her first note without a "tune up" and to know the first word!





