



Musical notes and chord progressions dictate dynamics.

Musical score dictates climactic builds and ebb and flow.

Many times the musical score without the text will set the emotional tone.



Transcending Technique

- Audience must be able to feel the emotion of the music performed because the performer is involved & is feeling it herself.
- Craft the lyrics so the song becomes a journey.
- Become a singing storyteller.
- Performer is emotionally engaged.
- Performing is iterative & synergistic—a shared conversation.

Artistry is an outcome of emotional connection.

- It's not a technique.
- It's not paint-by-number.
- It grows from an emotional message.
- When the effect is connected to the heart, it's artistry; when it's connected to the head, it's technique.
- Artistry is something you allow.
