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#### I. Competition Coordinator (CC) Welcome!

The Quartet contest will start at <u>3:00 PM</u> on Friday.

Quartets will be transported to the contest via large vans during the traffic pattern. There will not be shuttle buses to return to the hotel - please plan accordingly with your sisters in harmony.

#### Quartet photos will be taken at the PAC as part of the traffic pattern.

We are continuing with the new format for the International awards on Saturday afternoon. The <u>winning</u> chorus in <u>each division</u> will come to the stage to receive their medals and sing their acceptance song at that point. The winning Quartet and representatives for Region 16 at International in Louisville will join the new Chorus Champions on stage on Saturday afternoon and we will then announce the Regional awards at the conclusion of the distribution of all International awards.



An intermission will take place after the last competitor. The Blue Ribbon Club will be acknowledged from the podium but will not be singing.

Quartets will then be introduced in Order of Appearance for Announcement of Results. Quartets will come to the stage from the Audience.

#### VII. Contest Reminders – International Rules

- <u>Withdrawals:</u> Quartets must withdraw in writing (email is okay) to international headquarters. <u>A</u> phone call is not sufficient.
- <u>*Props rule:*</u> if any object is thrown into the audience or into the judging pit a penalty of 25 points up to the maximum of disqualification from the competition will be enforced.
- <u>Copyright Clearance</u>: All music must have cleared the copyright process. Failure to use cleared arrangements may result in disqualification. International Headquarters is responsible for administering the copyright policies and procedures.
- *Quartets Qualifying for International Competition:* Effective with the 2010 regional competition season, an additional invitation to compete will be offered should the first-place quartet withdraw or elect not to compete at International. If the quartet placing first in regional competitions chooses to withdraw from international Competitions prior to July 1, the second-place quartet will be invited to compete. If the second place quartet has already qualified as a wildcard or withdraws, this invitation will not extend to any other placement.
- Candid photographs will posted to a private and secure folder at <u>https://subuehler.com</u> for purchase beginning a few week after competition.
- All contestant performances will be DVD recorded. One performance DVD will be included in

your score sheet packet that is distributed immediately following competition. Additional copies may be ordered <u>following</u> the Convention weekend. Forms and instructions for additional DVD orders will be provided in your score sheet packet.

- Contestant score sheet packets will be distributed in the Judging Pit stage left side immediately after each contest session!
- Backstage entry is for the competitors and coaches only! Please observe the "authorized entry only" signs.
- Coaches who accompany a contestant backstage may watch the performance from Stage Left. The coach may then join the contestant following the performance through the remainder of the pattern.
- BRC VIP seating will be provided in rows 3 & 4 of the theatre for the Quartet contest ONLY.

#### Webcast

The quartet and chorus contests will again be webcast live from St. Catharines! Your webcast anchor is JD Crowe. She will be joined by Rob Snoulten for all of the quartet contest and most of chorus contest. Guest correspondents will be announced later!

A publicity campaign will soon be launched, and you will be encouraged to share the link to your chorus, quartet and personal social media pages to help spread the word. We hope you will forward to all of your family and friends as well so that they can live those precious minutes on stage with you from the comfort of their own home or office!

Think of webcasting not only as an opportunity to have your fans at home watch you live but also as an education tool for yourself, your quartet or chorus. How many times have you been excited about a late draw only to realize you won't get to see any of the contest? Well do we have a deal for you!!!! With a two-week archive period, you can watch at your leisure from home! You can even host a webcast viewing party with some of your chorus sisters! Great value for money!

We have maintained the webcast price at \$35 CAD. This price includes both the quartet and chorus contests.

#### A. Competitors Needing Special Assistance

#### B. Quartet Competition Traffic Pattern Information

- 1. Quartet gathers at assigned space front lobby area in each hotel adjacent to pick up point.
- 2. Quartet moves into van at designated departure point in each hotel. <u>Van will depart promptly on-</u> <u>time and will not wait for singers who may be late.</u>
- 3. Quartet arrives at Backstage Entrance to the PAC and is guided to photography.
- 4. Once photography is completed, Quartet is guided to the warm up room singing permitted, water available.
- 5. Quartet shown to backstage area and proceeds directly to the stage. Personal belongings may be left with the Convention Assistant backstage and will be returned in the Celebration room.

#### Please note:

- Quartet confirms stage performance entrance with Convention Assistant, stage right, stage left or split NO CENTER STAGE ENTRANCE.
- There is no quartet shell.
- A black drop curtain covers the entire width of the stage.
- The stage floor will be marked with tape indicating a toe line and centerline.
- A microphone will be placed approximately two feet down stage of the toe line.
- A monitor speaker will be in place either side of the microphone.
- 6. Quartet exits Stage Left to the hallway following performance.
- 7. Quartet is escorted from the backstage area directly to the webcast.
